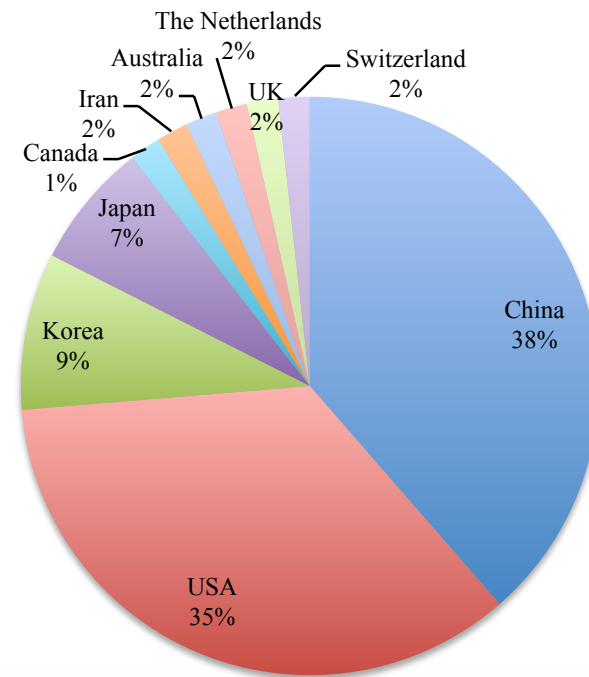

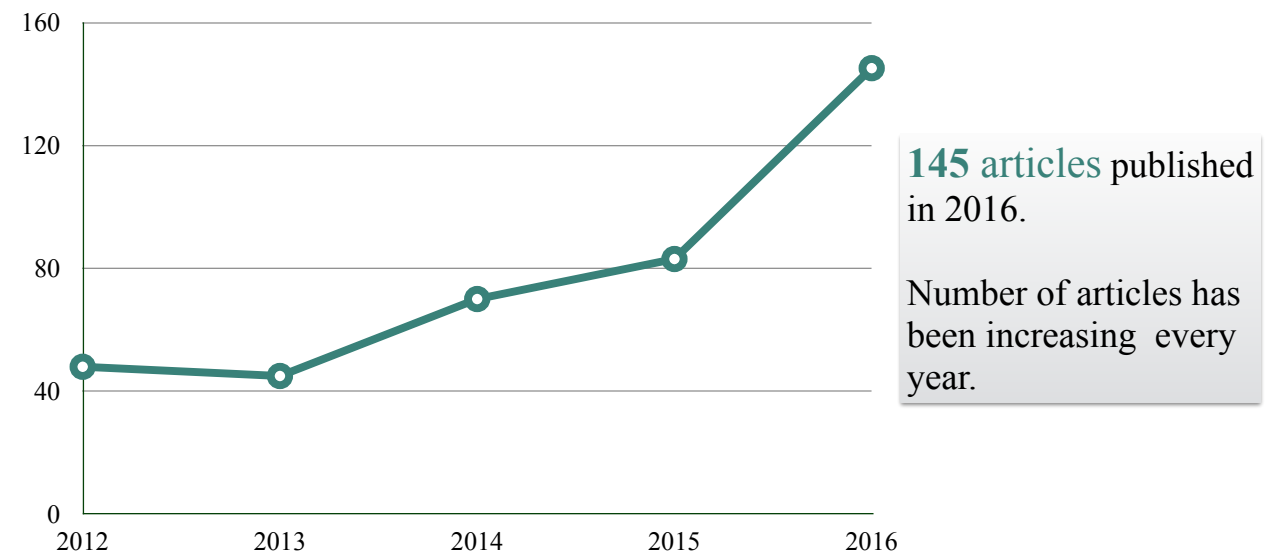
## 4. Distribution of Editorial Board Members



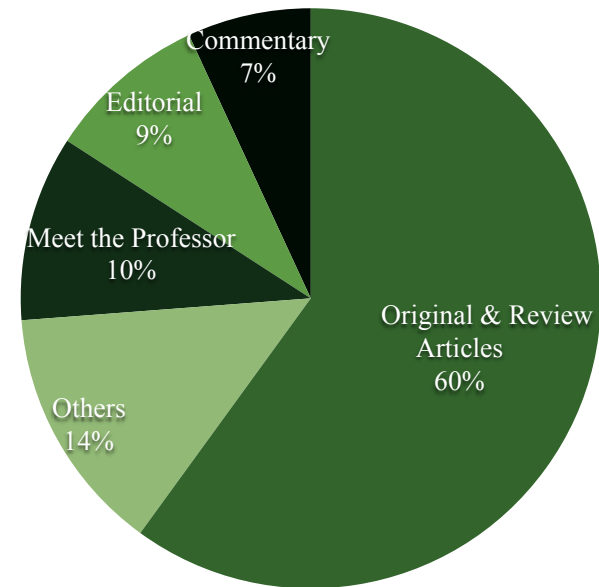

## 5. Number of Published Articles (results by year)

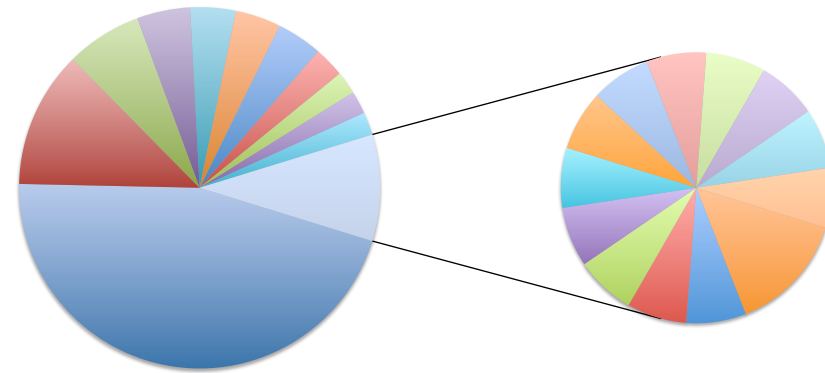


## 6. Diverse Types of Article Published in 2016



In 2016, TAU has published **145 manuscripts**, among which there are **87 review** articles and **original** articles. Other article types include preface, research highlight, correspondence, etc.

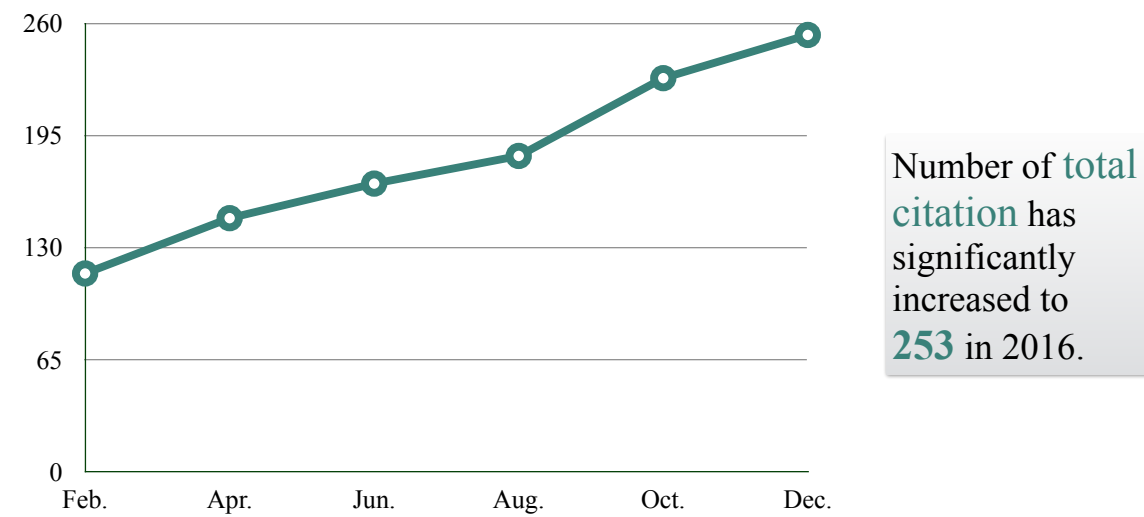

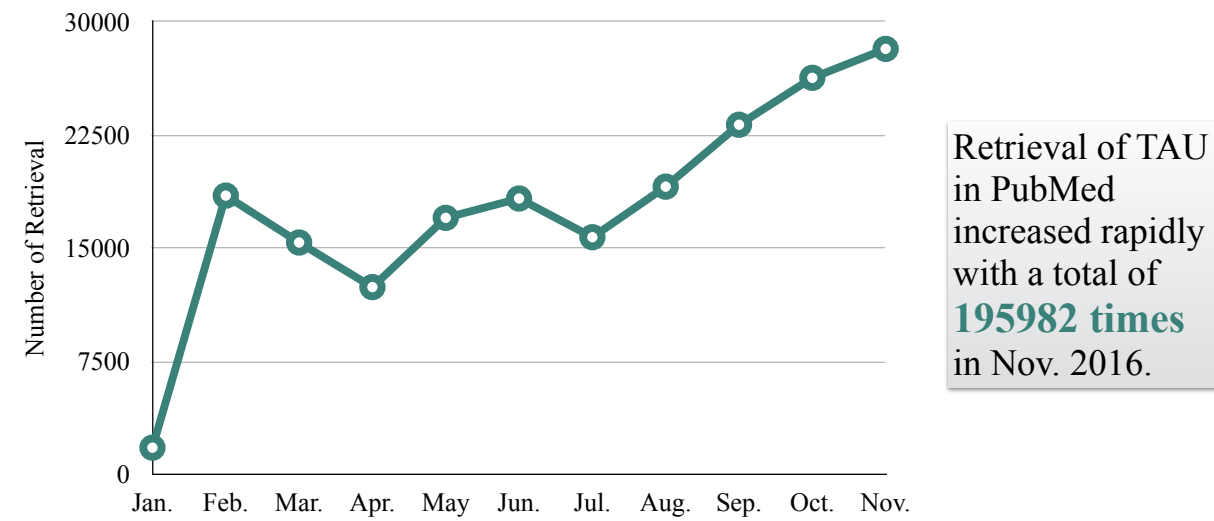

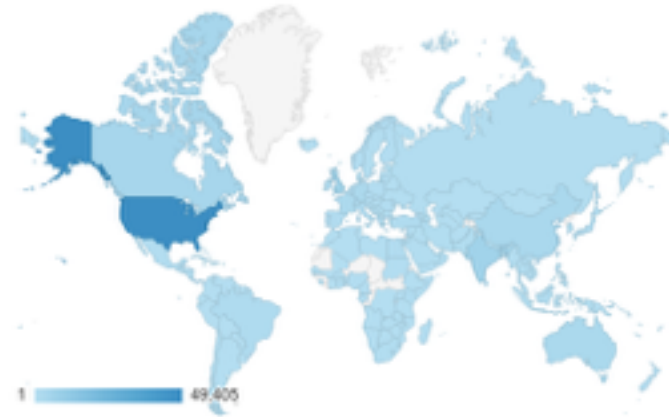


## 10. Monthly Retrievals in PubMed in 2016

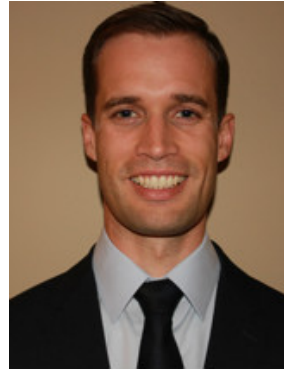

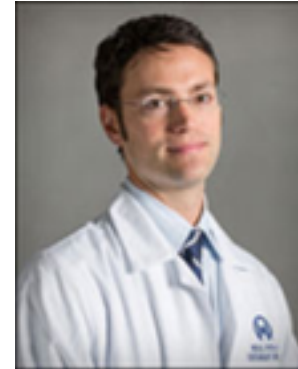
