


4. Distribution of Editorial Board Members







5. Number of Published Articles (results by year)




145 articles published in 2016.

6. Diverse Types of Article Published in 2016




In 2016, TAU has published 145 manuscripts, among which there are 87 review articles and original articles. Other article types include preface, research highlight, correspondence, etc.





7. International Diversity of Corresponding Authors in 2016




Corresponding authors of 145 articles published in 2016 come from 26 countries with 46% of them from USA.


